The DS-76 Sofa was launched as early as 1972, when it was considered revolutionary, no sofa bed could manage with a simpler mechanism: in a few simple steps, the model could be converted into a guest bed without mechanical support. (our photo just show one bed, but the second one can go down as well for a comfortable double bed!)

A special attraction of the DS-76 is the softly designed upholstery. Here the leather is pulled over the upholstery with less tension, so that a nice wrinkling is generated, for a p...
