Ultra-rare Turbo (also called Turbine) lamp designed by Louis Weisdorf in 1965, his highly successful design went into production two years later.

His designs often used repeating elements to form a uniquely shaped light. The design is best described as a sphere divided by spirals that together create a wonderful effect when viewed from different angles.

But this light is not only beautiful, it is also very practical! 99% of all surfaces of this luminaire are in a vertical direction. Because Weisdorf realised that building such a light would collect much less dust....
