Set of Three 'Soumba' Side Tables by Mathieu Matégot Constructed from perforated sheet metal, standing on brass feet.

Mathieu Matégot (1910-2001) was one of the most renowned French artists of the 1950s.

Previously a woman's clothing designer, he learned metalworking techniques as a prisoner of war in the 1940s and started designing furniture upon his release.

Matégot pioneered many of the characteristics we now recognise as defining Mid-Century design. This included metal-mounted rattan, steel tubing and the perforated metal seen in these tables.
